INTRODUCTION

Service to public is our motto. “Fire is a good servant but a bad master” is a saying which is true with every fire hazard. Fire hazards pose threats to life and property. Fires are the most common hazard in the state due to which many lives are lost and property are damaged. Hence, fire safety is a very important aspect of disaster management. Fires can be prevented with adequate planning and proactive response. Everyone know well about the services being rendered by the Fire Service Department at times of emergency.

During French reign, the Fire Services was commissioned as a branch of Police Department and until 1981, the Department functioned as one of the ingredients of Police Department. It was segregated from Police Department and attached with the Local Administration Department in the year 1981. In 1984, it was separated from the Local Administration Department and functioning as a separate Department under the control of Secretary to Government (Fire Service).

ADMINISTRATION

The Divisional Fire Officer is functioning as technical head of the Fire Service Department. The Fire Service Department started its services in 1956 with 2 Fire Stations one at Puducherry and the other at Karaikal. Now, it is functioning in all the four regions of Union Territory of viz. Puducherry, Karaikal, Mahe & Yanam. The Puducherry region consists nine numbers of Fire Stations, Two numbers in Karaikal, One each at Mahe and Yanam. Totally Thirteen numbers of Fire Stations are functioning in UT of Puducherry namely Puducherry, D' Nagar, Bahour, Villianur, Madukarai, Thirukkanur, Thirubuvanai, Kalapet, Sedarapet, Karaikal, Surakudy, Mahe & Yanam. Each Fire Station is headed by one Station Officer / Officer in - charge. A Station Officer and Fire Service Personnel crew on duty at the respective Local Fire Station (LFS) will be the first responder for all types of Fire Calls/Special Service Calls/Emergencies, which include natural and manmade disasters.

There are five sub-divisions namely Headquarter, North, South, West & Karaikal each under the control of respective Assistant Divisional Fire Officer for operational and administrative duties. In order to ensure effective command and control, the Fire Stations are grouped under the command of Asst. Divisional Fire Officer are as detailed below:

A separate **Fire Prevention Wing** headed by one Station Officer is functioning at the Office of the Divisional Fire Officer, in order to carry out the following functions:-

- (i) Inculcate the public on fire safety and prevention measures by propaganda through radio, TV, Press (Audio and Video) and conduct of mock drills at various establishments such as schools, hospitals, and other government buildings.
- (ii) Based on the request from various Departments and industrial establishments to ensure Fire Safety, testing of fire appliances and equipments installed in the building and advise them regarding fire prevention and protection measures to be adopted as per the recommendation of this Department.
- (iii) The built-in fire protection arrangements are recommended at the planning stage itself and ensured for the buildings like Hotels, Cinemas, Trading Centers, hospitals, schools, malls etc., where large public are assembled.

The Fire Service Week is observed from 14th April to 20th April as an annual feature throughout this Union Territory. The theme for every year is issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, GOI and based on the theme, wide publicity is made by depicting it through posters, banners, hand bills, cinema slides and conducting of essay competition for the students and prizes are awarded and conducting of mock drills at various establishments. Various steps are taken to inculcate the sense of fire safety amongst the citizens by demonstration, radio and TV programs which are arranged during the period.

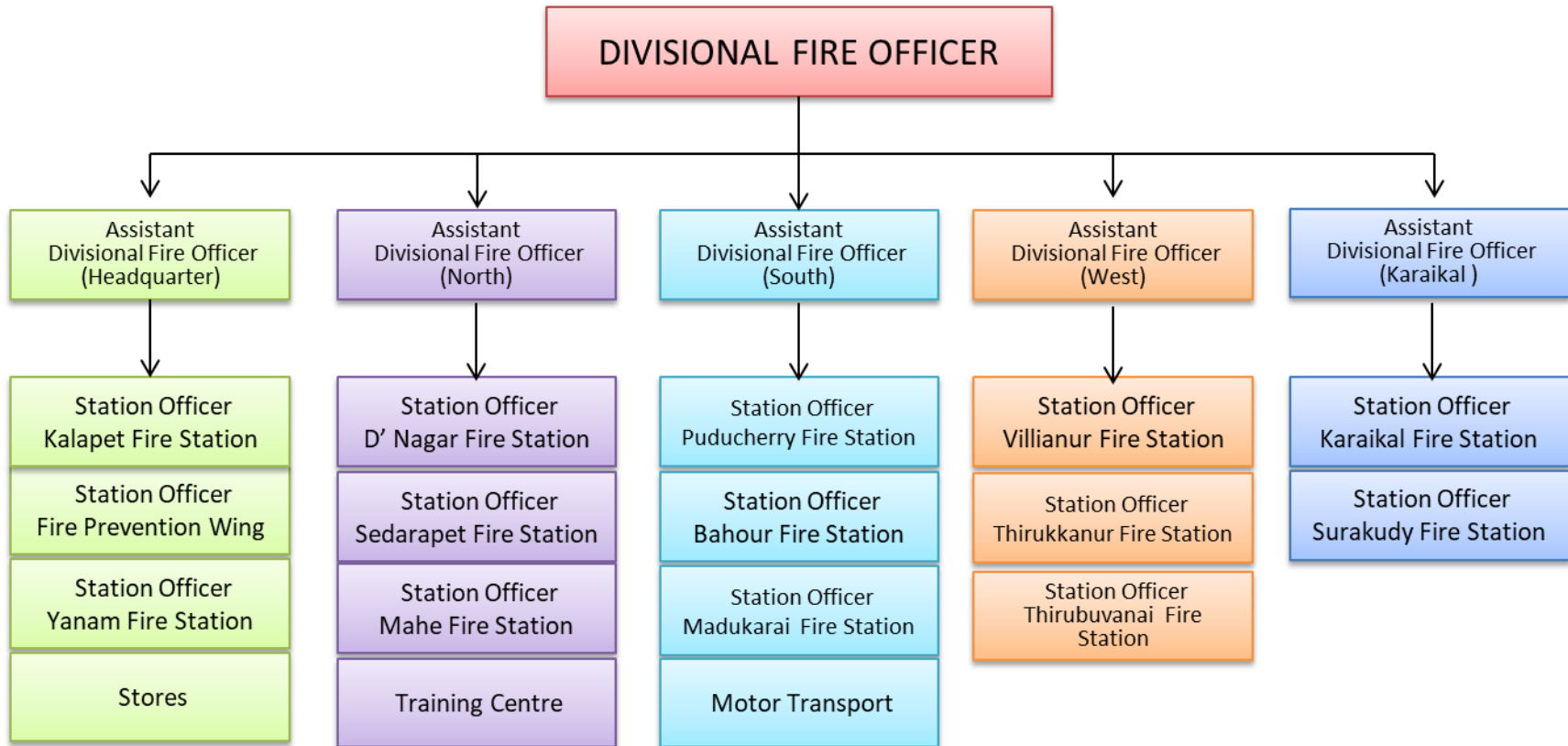

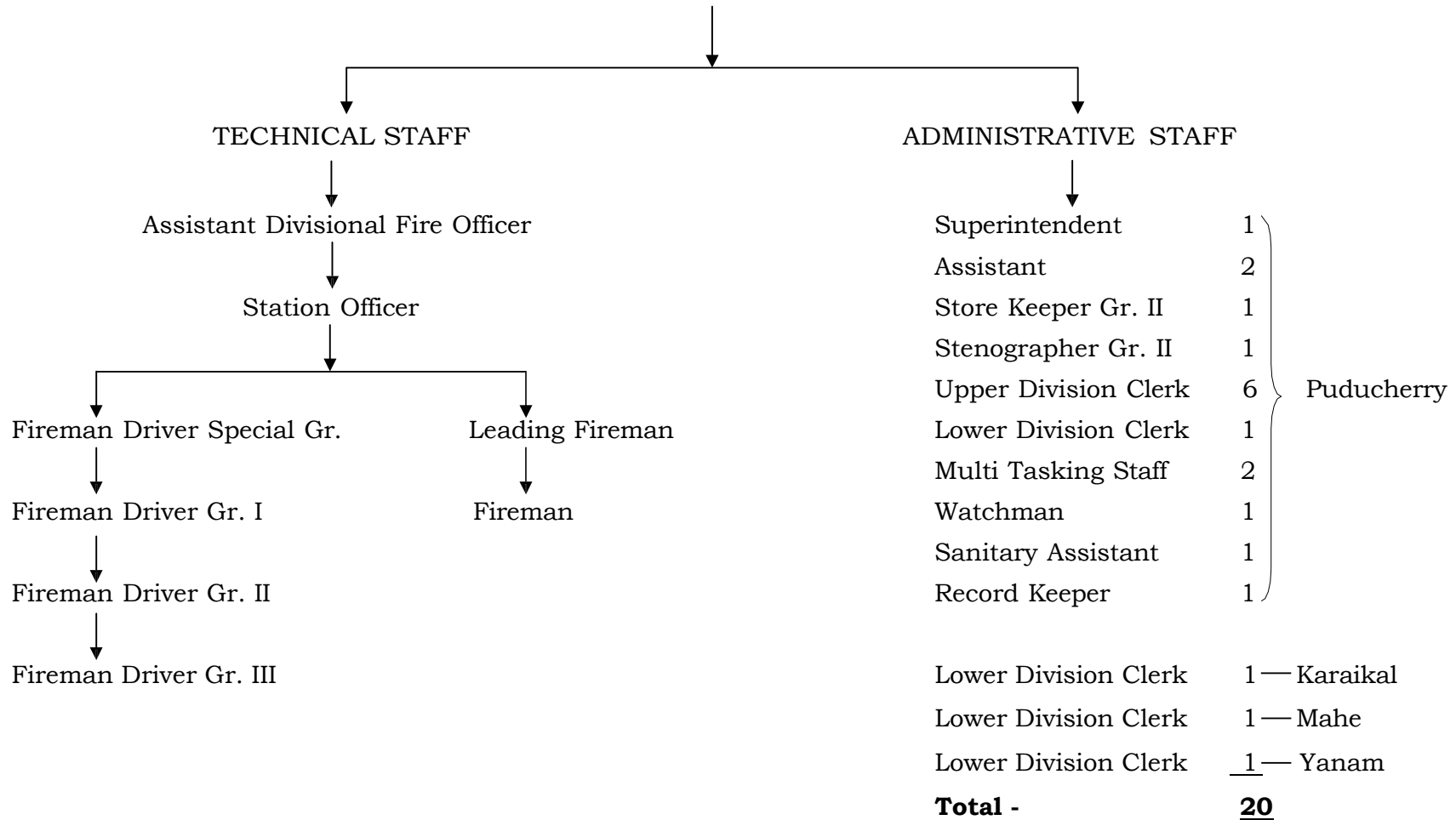
ORGANIZATION CHART

FUNCTIONING OF THE DEPARTMENT

The Service of this Department is available to the public round the Clock. **“We Serve to Save”**. & **“Service before self”** is the main motto of the Department. The basic objective of the Fire Service department is protection of life and property of the public during the fires and other calamities. The Department was declared as a First Responder cum Stake Holders as Emergency State Function ESF 4 & 14 by disaster management.

The Fire Service is rendering the following services to the public:

- (1) Rescue life and property of the people from devastating fires.
- (2) Search and Rescue people during natural calamities and made Disasters (Floods, Rains, Earthquakes, building collapse & fires).
- (3) Inculcate the public on fire prevention and ensure proper fire safety arrangements are adhered.
- (4) Help the affected people to resume their normal life during emergencies.
- (5) Special Services – Deployment of Fire Service crew with Fire Fighting Tenders as Fire Safety precautions during public gathering at the time of Kumbabishegam, Exhibitions, Circus, VVIP’s visits, Airports and other Government functions.
- (6) Attending Special Service Calls such as Rescuing person from Well, Ponds, Lakes etc. removing of Wasp & honey Combs, Rescue of Animals, clearing of Oil spillages on roads to avert accidents etc.
- (7) Audit/Inspection of buildings both Government/private and issue of No Objection Certificate / issue of fire protection recommendations, for the grant of license to trades and industries involving fire risk.

Fire Control Room 101:-

The main objective of the Department is to save the life and property of the people from devastating fires. The fire Control Room 101 is located at the Puducherry Fire Station/Watch Rooms are available at every Fire Station. They are manned round the Clock in two shifts at all Fire Stations to receive calls and information about any outbreak of fire/emergencies. All Fire Stations are provided with telephone facility for receipt of fire message through telephone or messenger (running caller). The person receiving the call will take down the vital information such as location of the fire, the time of its outbreak, its nature and location of the spot in case of Special Service Call etc. and turn out the available appliances with the crew to the spot. The in-charge official of the Control Room/Watch Room will make necessary arrangements for reinforcements of additional fire units according to the nature of fire/Special Service and inform the concerned higher ups for further action.

The on duty Fire crew is kept alert and ready to move at any time, with no time delay on the receipt of information about the outbreak of fire/emergency. The first 30 seconds after the outbreak of fire are most crucial. An average fire is likely to spread 10 times bigger after 2 minutes and 50-100 times bigger after 4 minutes. It will be surprised to know that the fire units are turned out to respond the fire call within 60 seconds on receipt of information.

- 1. Rescue of people from natural calamities:-** This Department is rendering selfless services during natural calamities. The Fire Service Personnel are engaged in rescue and evacuate people from the low lying areas/flood affected places and building collapses etc., round the clock at the time of cyclone and heavy rain from the affected area.
- 2. Special Standby duties:-** This Fire Service is deputed Fire tenders with crew for standby duties as fire safety precautions during public gatherings at the time of Kumbabishegam, Exhibition, Circus and VVIP's visit, state functions etc..

3. Recommendations pertaining to the issue of licence to industrial establishments:- The licensing authorities, District Magistrate, Commissioner of Municipalities and other agencies are consulting Fire Service Department before issue of licence for all the trades and industries involving fire risk and issue of licence. The Fire Service Department after actual inspection of the premises and suggesting proper fire fighting arrangements to the concerned, issue 'No Objection Certificate' to the licensing authorities after ensuring the fire safety.

4. Help people to restore their normal life:- The responsibility of the Fire Service do not end with fire fighting. They also help people to restore their normal life as follows:

- (1) Recording correct name and address of the victim and recommend them for getting relief from Government and other agencies.
- (2) Issue Fire Accident Certificate so as to enable the people to obtain the following:-
 - (i) Fresh policy from Electricity Department to resume power connection.
 - (ii) Duplicate ration cards other identity cards issued by the Government.
 - (iii) Duplicate documents of property / Assets etc.

- (iv) To exchange the half burnt currencies from bank.
- (v) Duplicate identity cards other proof of identities etc.
- (vi) Recommends getting loan from bank and other agencies to restore normal life and rebuild the burnt house.
- (vii) To get fire insurance claim, etc.

APPLIANCES/EQUIPMENTS AVAILABLE

Every Fire Station is provided with one or two Fire tenders of the appropriate category. Various types of articulated appliances are available with the department viz., Water Tender, Emergency Tender, Rescue Tender, Foam Tender, Feeder Unit, Small Fire Engine, Airladder Platform, besides the life saving equipments Hydraulic cutting tools, Chain Saw operated by both petrol and battery, Insect Protection Suits, Life Buoy & Life Jackets, Aluminium fire entry Suits, Inflatable Lighting Tower, Breathing Apparatus Sets etc.

FIRE PREVENTION ACTIVITIES

Fire Accidents don't just happen. The real cause behind every fire outbreak is carelessness, negligence or ignorance on the part of the people. Fires are serious hazard with devastating results. Fire destroys the life of people and property earned with persistent efforts and sacrifice in a moment of carelessness causing loss of life, injuries and grave damage. The loss due to fire cannot be replaced. The fire accidents with devastating results could be avoided, if we are careful.

Fire prevention means the efforts for eliminating the outbreak of fires by adopting all possible precautionary safety measures. Fire prevention is considered even more important than firefighting itself. The scope of fire prevention is not only limited to industries but it is equally important to all the establishments like government buildings, Shops, educational buildings, residential buildings, cracker shops, Hospitals, places for Entertainment, like Multiplex, museums, resorts, orphanages, old age homes, street food stalls, Theatres, Hotels, Malls, Marriage Halls, temples, electrical sub stations, etc. The spread of fire could be controlled and loss can be minimized.

FIRE PREVENTION IN INDUSTRIES

The workers and the Dwellers / Occupants are trained to identify the reasons for fire outbreak, how to avoid fire risk, how to save themselves from fire, how to call Fire Service, how to use fire extinguishers, how to save others from fire etc. fire fighting training (Mock Drills) and demonstrations are conducted to them.

The fire appliances/installations must have to be checked at periodical intervals by a competent Fire Officer. Proper fire safety arrangements and its authentications are ensured by the Fire Officers concerned.

FIRE PREVENTION IN URBAN AND RURAL

The fire risk lurks mostly in kitchen and usage of combustible materials. In order to avoid fire risk, the kitchen should be kept neat and clean with proper housekeeping. Highly inflammable oil and other things should be kept away from stove. Stove should not be placed under low roof thatched shed. While cooking, using of synthetic and fiber clothes should be avoided. Only cotton clothes should be used. It is safer to use apron while cooking. Cook with care in gas stove. While using gas stove, turn on the burner knob only after striking a match. After use, shut both cylinder valve and burner knob every time. Children should not be allowed to play in kitchen with matches. Burning matchsticks should not be thrown here and there. Children should be advised to burn crackers outdoor under the supervision of the Elders for safety. Avoid placing kerosene stoves on the ground. Huts should be erected at intervals.

FIRST-AID SEVERE BURNS

For severe burns, pour cold water over burns till the pain subsides and cover with a clean cloth and consult to a Doctor.

DUTIES OF PUBLIC

In case of fire on your dress, don't panic and run. Running will aggravate the fire. The procedure is STOP/DROP/ROLL on the ground will help to douse the fire. It helps to pour cold water over the burns till the pain subsides. Don't apply any ointment without medical advice.

As and when fire outbreaks, try to extinguish it with the available means such as fire extinguishers or installed fire protection measures and inform the nearby Fire Service Station (Toll Free: 101) simultaneously. Give way to the fire fighting vehicles and its crew / unit. Help the Fire Service personnel by giving correct particulars of address and availability of water sources and the nature of the house of fire, number of persons in the house and things inside, etc. so as to enable the Fire Service personnel to control the risk at their best.

HOW TO APPLY FOR FIRE CERTIFICATE

For obtaining certificate regarding the involvement of the premises in the actual fire accident, written application should be submitted to the concerned Station Fire Officer. On receipt of application, the certificates will be issued within stipulated time.

HOW TO APPLY FOR THE NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE

For obtaining the “No Objection certificate” from the Fire Service department for the Industrial Units, Trading Centers, malls, Educational Institutions, Hospitals, Clinics, etc. the applicants has to apply to The Divisional Fire Officer, Fire Service Department, Puducherry through the **EODB online portal** along with the details of activities/business the sketch of the site building with other details. For all types of traders apply through concerned Municipality and commune panchayats. On receipt of application, the certificate will be issued within the stipulated time based on the National Building Code (Part 4 Fire and Life Safety).
